Other Speakers from USA included Stephen Pierce, a Strategy and Product Creation Expert and Rick Raddatz, Audio and Video Marketing Expert. Dr. Marc Dussault is a Marketing and Copywriting Expert who says the Internet is a "skill ability"- very powerful and a great leveler where the only thing we need is theory and practice. Hosting in the internet, he claims, can grow your business exponentially creating big profits with very little effort which anyone can apply immediately.
